



History

- Established in 1917 by John Ringling
- Encompasses residences and shopping centers
- Harding Circle received historic designation in 2001
- Home of the Circus Ring of Fame – with names and history of performers and circus executives
- Contains statues and public art features





The project is located in St. Armands Key, Sarasota, FL, and extends to:


- >Pansy Bayou Bridge to the North



PD&E and Design 100% funded by City

Project will follow Federal and FDOT requirements; seek Federal Grant for construction

Project Costs ~\$45,000,000+

10 – 15 years to complete

Project Lifecycle 30+ years



LIMIT IMPACT TO RESIDENTIAL STREETS

Project Funding, Cost, & Timeline

PD&E and Design 100% funded by City

Seek MPO funds for construction

Project Costs ~\$15,000,000+

2 - 3 years to complete

Project Lifecycle 10+ years
















St. Armands Key Complete Streets

The purpose of the St. Armands Key Complete Streets project is to improve pedestrian walkability, transportation facilities, enhance safety and ADA, beautify the right-of way, and support economic growth.

St. Armands Key receives over 600,000 visitors annually that support more than 100 businesses along the streets of St. Armands Circle. It is home to approximately 1,000 people. The St. Armands Key project would serve both the residents and businesses that live, work, and play in St. Armands.

A complete street is an age-friendly design that promotes safe travel to and from a destination, whether walking, biking, riding the bus or driving a vehicle. Features may include enhanced sidewalks, street lighting, benches, street trees and landscaping, public art and more.
