

# Planning Department COMMUNITY WORKSHOP APPLICATION NO. 18-CW-18 DISCUSSION OF TWO MINOR CONDITIONAL USES

As required by the City of Sarasota, a community meeting is being held to discuss two Minor Conditional Uses for a  $0.60\pm$  acre property located at 2221 2<sup>nd</sup> Street (Please see map on reverse side). The owner of the subject property, Second Street One LLC, proposes to use the property as a Motor Vehicle Repair Shop for the restoration and service of rare and collectable cars. As defined in Section II-201 of the City's Zoning Code, a Motor Vehicle Repair Shop is "a building, structure, enclosure or premises in or on which the general business of repairing motor vehicles is conducted, including body shop, engine rebuilding or reconditioning, upholstering, radiator reconditioning and repairing, and similar industrial processes. Incidental servicing of motor vehicles is permitted." The subject property is within the Downtown Edge (DTE) zone district, which is consistent with the Future Land Use Designation of Urban Edge.

In addition, the applicant proposes to use the subject property as Motor Vehicle Sales Agency for the purpose of providing a potential common use between the subject property and the adjacent property located at 2277 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, should 2277 2<sup>nd</sup> Street be approved for use as a Motor Vehicle Sales Agency. Although owned by separate entities, the neighboring properties have the potential for a symbiotic relationship where the high-end automobiles sold at 2277 2<sup>nd</sup> Street could also be serviced at 2221 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. The applicant envisions cars to be unloaded from 2277 2<sup>nd</sup> Street directly to 2221 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for servicing, and in order to benefit from this symbiotic relationship, the subject property must be approved both as a Motor Vehicle Repair Shop and a Motor Vehicle Sales Agency.
